#### Financial Reconciliation - Referee Fees

All team managers in Hockey 3 and older would have received an advance at the beginning of the season to cover balancing/placement, league and playoff games. A reconciliation form is required to be submitted to our bookkeeper, Katie, *no later than March 10*. This form will identify any shortage/overage for your team, and if you require additional funds, this form will need to be submitted prior to a cheque being sent.

- If you haven't already done so, download the form from the Vancouver Thunderbirds website. Click on "Forms" (located along the top bar), "Game Officials", in the section "Game Official Fees"
- Complete and submit to Katie kmak@vancouvertbirds.ca by March 10
- If you did not use all the funds provided, for initiation and recreational teams, please send a cheque to the Association office (#170 4438 W 10th Ave, Vancouver, BC, V6R 4R8). This must be received no later than March 20. For rep teams, the fees should remain in the Association provided bank account for removal.
- If you ended up paying more in ref fees than you were provided, please ensure you include the name a cheque should be made to and an address to send it to.

Remember, the Association only covers balancing/placment, league and playoff games. We do not cover exhibition or tournament games and these games should not be listed on your reconciliation form.

Note that if you are owed any funds, you will need to submit your reconciliation form no later than March 3 to be included on the cheque run for March. Any forms received after this date will be included in the cheque run for the April 12 board meeting.

#### **Jerseys and Equipment Return**

Our outstanding equipment manager, Chris, who volunteers hours of his time taking great care of all of us, has asked that the following be done with regards to returning all Association items:

- All jerseys are to be washed, and returned on wire hangers
- Jerseys are to be in numerical order in each colour (blue set and white set)
- In case you have forgotten, all Atom to Midget teams should be returning 20 blues and 20 whites
- All pant shells (rep only) are to be washed
- All goalie gear from Hockey 1 through to Atom Rep to be returned in the goalie bags provided at the beginning of the season. Note, for Hockey 1-4, goalie sticks are not to be returned
- Puck bag including pucks, cones and first aid kits must be returned
- All As, Cs, name bars and sponsorhip patches/bars, and all stitching must be fully removed. Any damaged jerseys will not have their. jersey deposit returned so please be careful when removing these

Once you have all of the items, please email Chris at equipment@vancouvertbirds.ca to arrange for a time to drop it off. Please note that he will not open the door unless you have all the items....ok, perhaps he's not that strict but he really does ask that you only need to make one trip so you collect everything before you arrange to meet with him.
