


TBirds Win PCAHA Bursaries










Coach Services

Results of the Audit

Audit Process

 We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. The objective of our audit was to obtain reasonable, not absolute, assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

Materiality

- Approximately 3% of revenues or \$48,000
- Audit differences >\$2,400 reported to Management and Board
- Accounting Standards
 - Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Standards for Non-profits
- No significant deficiencies in internal controls
- Reminder A financial statement audit is not a forensic or fraud audit; not a report or audit of internal controls



Results of the Audit

- Good cooperation of Management to obtain access to the information and records to perform our audit. Able to execute an effective audit remotely to address COVID-19 risks. We met (virtually) with the Finance Committee and the Board to discuss the results of our audit and obtain the Board's approval of the financial statements.
- Information exchanged by secure client portal to ensure privacy and data security.
- Due to nature of donations and fundraising revenue, we issued a
 Qualified Opinion with respect to the completeness of
 donations. Extremely common for organizations who collect
 donations or perform fundraising. Consistent with the prior year.



Results of the Audit

- We have discussed with management the impact of Covid-19 to date, as well as the expected future impact. All audit testing in this area was executed as planned with no issues to be reported, including review of CEWS and CEBA grants. FS disclosures were included in the financial statements. Cash flows and operations will continue to be monitored by Management and the Board.
- In our opinion, except for the possible effect regarding the completeness of donations, the financial statements present fairly the financial position of the Vancouver Thunderbirds Association for the year ended March 31, 2021 and the results of its operations and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with ASNPO.



Last season: 2020-21 U6-U9






Skills, \$243, 24%




Last season: 2020-21 Recreational

In the event of a vote...

- Each member is eligible to cast one vote
- If a member votes for more choices than positions to be elected, the vote is considered illegal
- If a member votes for fewer choices than positions to be elected, the vote is a legal vote
