

Rep Player / Parent Commitment & Expectation Agreement 2021-22 Season

Rep Hockey brings together dedicated, skilled players and dedicated, experienced coaches to form teams to play with the best hockey players and coaches from other associations. It is a choice and a privilege to be part of a Rep Hockey team. Thunderbirds Rep Hockey requires players to attend all scheduled team activities and support of their teammates.

The foundation of the Rep Program is commitment, dedication, and a desire to make a positive contribution.

Players are expected to:

- be a good representative of Thunderbirds in their words and actions to their teammates, team staff, game officials, opponents, and venue staff
- support their teammates on and off the ice

Parents/Guardians are expected to:

- support and encourage their player and their team
- avoid scheduling conflicts with the team activities so their player can be fully committed to their team*
- make Thunderbirds hockey the top hockey priority for their player
- * Multi-sport athletes in U11 and U13 may be able to arrange with the team coach to accommodate conflicts for occasional team practices due to involvement in another sport activity. Missing any team practices may impact on the player's assignments in upcoming game play and should be discussed in full with the head coach in advance. Note that this does NOT apply for another hockey program as it is not an additional "multi" sport.

The expectations for Rep Hockey players and their Parents/Guardians are high. The player will be challenged so they can develop and excel and be a positive contributor to their team made up of coaching staff, officials, supporters, and fellow teammates who are also committed to Rep Hockey.
